PLAINTIFFS' REQUESTS FOR
EXTENSIONS OF CERTAIN
DEADLINES

This matter is before the Court to address the plaintiffs' requests for extension of certain deadlines established by Pretrial Scheduling Order No. 4. (Pls.' Letter, ECF No. 191; Pretrial Sch. Order No. 4, ECF No. 155.) The Court held a telephonic hearing on the plaintiffs' requests and the plaintiffs, CenturyLink, and the Proposed Intervenors appeared through counsel. During the telephonic hearing, the Court granted the plaintiffs' requests in part and denied them in part. Consistent with the Court's decision, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. **On or before August 23, 2018**, the plaintiffs shall file and serve their briefs in opposition to the motions to compel arbitration, intervene, and dismiss.
- 2. **On or before August 2, 2018**, the plaintiffs shall serve responses to defendant's interrogatories, document requests, and requests for admission.
- 3. **On or before October 23, 2018**, the defendant shall file its reply brief in support of its motion to compel arbitration and motion to dismiss.
- 4. This Order does not alter the November 14, 2018 hearing on the pending motions to compel arbitration, intervene, and dismiss. United States District Court Judge Michael J. Davis will notify the parties if the November 14th hearing date will be moved.
