- 2. The Laima Flynn v. Howmedica Osteonics Corp., d/b/a Stryker Orthopaedics, Stryker Corp., Stryker Sales Corporation and Stryker Ireland Limited matter is hereby **DISMISSED** in its entirety **WITHOUT PREJUDICE**.
